

Crystal City Sector Plan, Information Update
E2C2, Meeting Summary -
Mar. 22, 2010

Committee Discussion/Remarks

- With regards to the Wastewater Treatment Plant, the plan could recommend strategies that minimize any additional demand that new development and buildings may place on the capacity of the plant.
- The recommendations specifying strategies to re-use grey-water may be too limiting, and it may be better to consider encouraging full water re-use, using on-site package plants that can help achieve zero discharge.
- In light of the Community Energy Plan (CEP) efforts underway, the Crystal City Plan has to include a strategy (or strategies) that allows for a placeholder in the Plan to defer to implementing any of the outcomes of the CEP that may influence future infrastructure or development in Crystal City.
- Would like to stay apprized of the schedule for the release of the revised draft plan, in case the commission would like to communicate advice to the Board on the matter.
